

# Eggshell Plant

## You will need:

Eggshell  
Potting soil  
Grass or bean seeds  
Paint or markers  
Glue  
Cardboard or pipe cleaner

## Instructions:

- 1) Rinse out your eggshell and dry it gently. Be careful not to break it!
2. To create a solid base, glue a small piece of cardboard (or a pipe cleaner bent in a circle) to the bottom of the eggshell. Set aside until the glue is dry.
3. Using paint or markers, decorate your eggshell. Faces look good (the plant becomes the hair), but you could also use stripes or abstract designs. It's up to you! If you use paint, set the eggshell aside til it's dry.
4. Loosely fill your egg with potting soil to about the halfway mark. Add a pinch of grass seeds (or two bean seeds, in case one doesn't germinate) and cover with a thin layer of soil. Now sprinkle lightly with water to give your seeds a drink!
5. Just wait! Grass seeds will take a few weeks to germinate, but beans should only take a few days. Once they sprout, move your egg to a sunny spot and keep it watered. Enjoy your new plant!
